



Attention: DJHL Game Officials

Please be advised of the following with respect to DJHL Play-off Games:

- 1. A team must have 14 skaters and 1 goalie by the start of the game to avoid default.**
- 2. Time-outs are only permitted in Peewee A or Bantam A play-off games. Each team is permitted one 30 second time-out per game.**
- 3. Players receiving 3 penalties (separate infractions) in any DJHL game will be automatically ejected from the game. Double minors only count as one infraction.**
- 4. In Best of 3 or Best of 5 series play, if teams are tied at the end of regulation time in any playoff game, then the game will be decided by shootout.**
- 5. In any two-game total goal series, if teams are tied on goal aggregate (total goals scored by a team over two games) at the end of regulation time after game #2, then the series will be decided by a shootout. No shootout is permitted after a regulation tie in game #1 of such a series.**
- 6. The shootout procedure is as follows:**
 - a. Initially each team identifies 3 players to participate in the shootout;**
 - b. Home team shoots first;**
 - c. The team with the most goals after each has taken 3 shots is the winner;**
 - d. If the score is tied after 3 shots, each team will proceed to alternate shots until a winner is declared;**
 - e. No player can shoot twice until every player has taken a shot; and**
 - f. If a player was in the penalty box at the end of regulation time they will not be allowed to participate in the shootout.**
- 7. Proper game sheet reporting is important to the DJHL. Therefore, scorekeepers must keep the game sheet very neat and readable (and lean on the pen to ensure good carbon copies!).**
